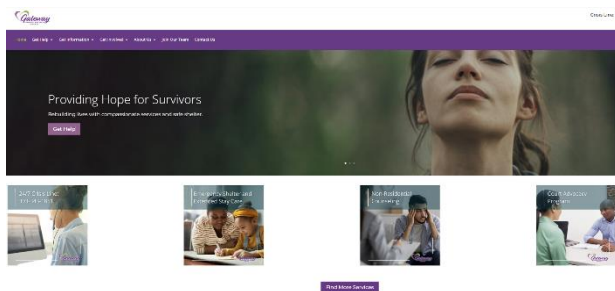

Gateway Expands Counseling Access with Bilingual Spanish Counselor

We are pleased to announce the Non-Residential Program Team has added a new master's level Bilingual Counselor to its roster. Spanish speaking clients will be able to receive both individual and group counseling services in their native language.

A six-week psychoeducational group was recently completed where group members are offered education on the dynamics of domestic violence. In addition to the knowledge gained, group members find a supportive community that helps reduce the sense of isolation experienced in abusive relationships. When asked about her experience in the group, one group member stated: ***"I truly appreciate the facilitators and the other group members' kindness and encouragement. I felt like our group was a safe space to be vulnerable about anything.
